## PACK A PORTABLE EMERGENCY SUPPLY KIT

*A waterproof backpack or suitcase on wheels works great!*

- ✓ Collar with your pet's current identification and rabies tags, as well as a secure leash or harness.
- ✓ Bowls, plenty of water and food for at least three days, as well as cleanup items such as plastic bags or a litter pan and litter.
- ✓ Blanket, flashlight and batteries, liquid soap, and baby wipes.
- ✓ Collapsible crate or pet carrier, a blanket or sheet to cover the crate for your pet's solitude, and your pet's favorite toy for comfort.
- ✓ Human and animal first aid kits. Don't forget to pack prescribed medications for you and your pet. Flea and tick treatment is also important for significant rain or flooding events.
- ✓ A fully charged cell phone.



## DON'T FORGET IMPORTANT PAPERWORK TO HELP PROVE OWNERSHIP AND ENSURE YOUR PET'S CARE!

*TIP: Create a folder on your mobile phone with photos of these records so they are always accessible.*

- Current photograph of you and your pet together to show authorities in case you are separated.
- Medical records indicating vaccination dates and your pet's microchip ID number.
- A list of any medications your pet takes and why.
- Proof of ownership, including copies of adoption or purchase paperwork, registration information, and microchip enrollment confirmation.



## AT THE FIRST MENTION OF A PENDING DISASTER

- ✓ Bring your pets inside so you won't have to search for them if you need to evacuate quickly.
- ✓ Make sure your pet's collar is securely fastened with legible ID tags.
- ✓ Have your portable supply kit ready to grab-and-go with everything you and your pet need. Consider making duplicate kits—just in case.
- ✓ Call emergency shelters ahead of time to confirm pet-friendly accommodations.
